
For the record - yes I do hunt, and yes I did freeze my ass off in the RAIN this year. And no, I did not see one damn deer let alone get to shoot at one... 💝

smoothies. So I propose the top 5 reasons why neck beards suck.




2. They're awkward. Now this is an understatement. A neck beard looks like you have a cat (unshaved this time) strapped to your






