How to Not Piss off Your Server

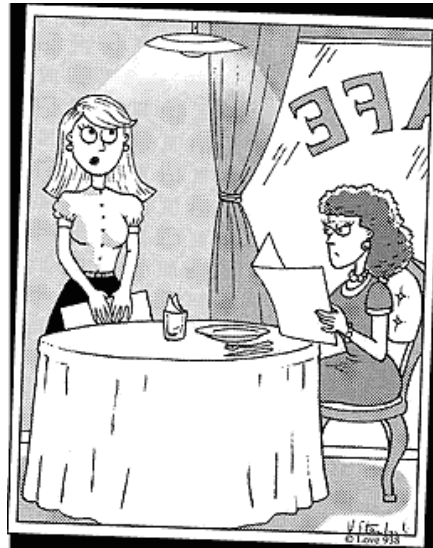

Treat us well and we will treat you well. We are servers, not servants. Being polite to your server goes a long way. We also remember the people who treat us like people as much as we remember the assholes who treat us like trash.
