Tech Revises Snow Day Policy, Cancels Classes for Next 25 Years

In response to public sentiment that "Tech doesn't care about its students" when deciding to cancel classes due to inclement weather, the University Senate has unanimously approved plans to cancel nearly all classes for the next 25 years.
