Every week I try to highlight a special place to visit in the Keweenaw, since the worst thing you can do in our area is not enjoy all the amazing scenery we have to offer. This week's spot isn't off the map - it's Hungarian Falls, which is arguably one of the most visited places around. Usually I wouldn't highlight such a famous place already, but I'm making an exception because it's been in the news quite a lot recently.

Hungarian Falls is actually an entire gorge full of waterfalls along Dover Creek, just above Hubbell and Tamarack City. The main falls gets a lot of the credit for the fame, as it is the largest at easily over 50 feet tall. The middle falls, which has one of the most beautiful drops you'll find in the U.P., is around 25 feet tall and is by far the most popular to stop and gander at. A tiny drop lies directly above these falls on the upstream side. These falls are all located on Michigan DNR land and are open to everyone's enjoyment.

Finally, we have the uppermost falls far above the impounded pond and dam. Often overlooked, these falls are as high as the middle falls and feature an impressive cascade down a rocky basalt face. It was this drop that was put up for sale last winter, and after an impressive show of community fundraising support, was purchased by the Keweenaw Land Trust (KLT) this past September. Now in the public trust, the 10-acre parcel that contains the dam, pond, and uppermost falls will remain open to the public forever.


