No, NOT in your pants, PETER!!!

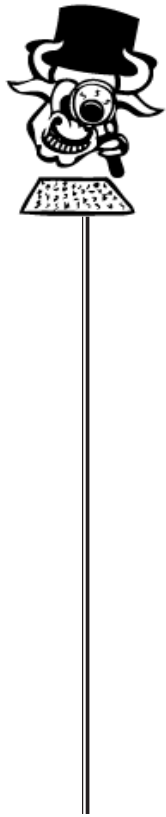
