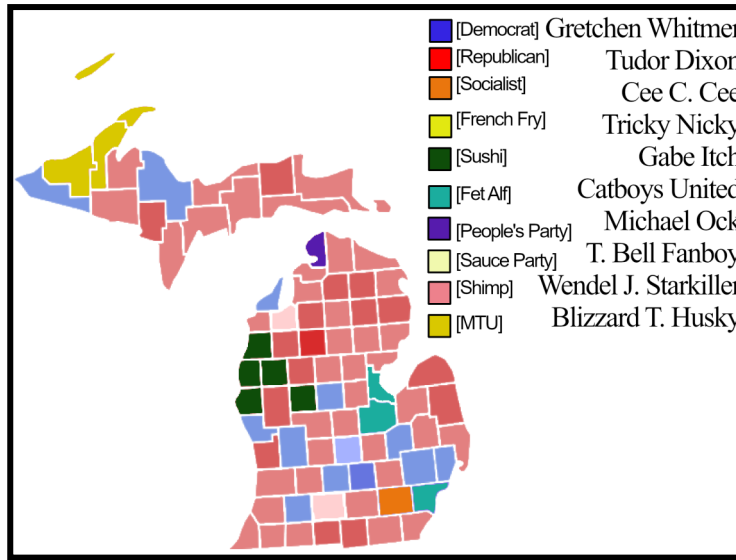
**Tricky Nicky - French Fry Panther Party**

Amends the Michigan constitution to state that it does not provide the right for a little salami or require the funding of a little salami, as a treat or otherwise


