I submit the following information to the DOW missing printer case:

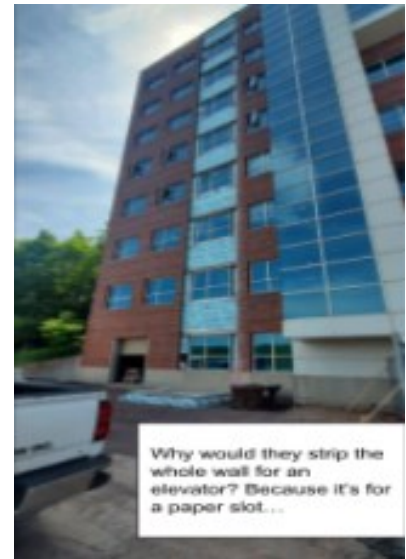
