DETROIT, MI — As more than 18,000 members of the United Auto Workers (UAW) from over 40 auto plants are on strike demanding higher pay, retirement benefits, and job security in the face of the rise of EV, leadership in the Big Three are debating whether to replace the union workers with robots or immigrants.
