HSTEM Soft-Opens to the Public

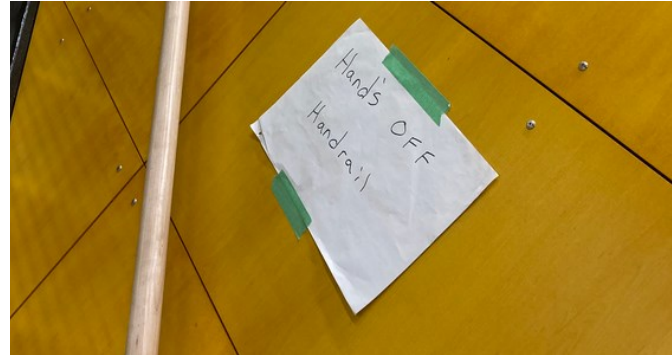
