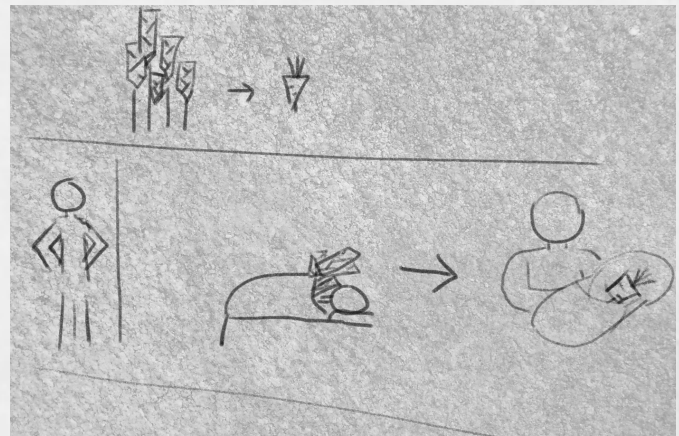
Days Since Sumer was a

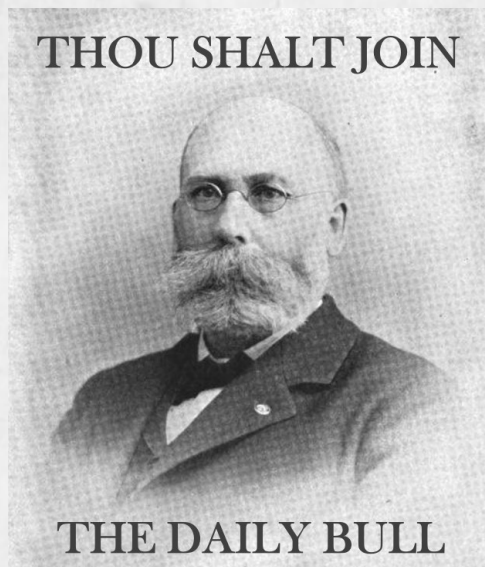
